Serve as a Certification & Accreditation (C&A) Project Engineer with subject matter expert knowledge of Department of Defense/Department of the Navy Certification and Accreditation policies, procedures and processes. This position requires extensive knowledge of the Department of Defense Information Assurance Certification and Accreditation Process (DIACAP) requirements. The candidate will facilitate the collaboration of meetings with government and contractor C&A representatives to execute C&A activities for on-site solutions and enterprise Authority to Operate. Facilitate Information Assurance Engineering Interoperability meetings for network integration between Navy Marine Corp Intranet (NMCI)/Next Generation Enterprise Network (NGEN), Information Technology for the 21st Century (IT-21), and OCONUS Navy Enterprise Network (ONE-Net). In collaboration with C&A representatives, develop processes and provide documentation for the Enterprise DIACAP Plan.

Critical Competencies:

Work with other subject matter experts to define C&A technical requirements and allocate the requirements to the project and satisfy those requirements. Candidate must have keen knowledge of the DIACAP process. Candidate must be able to apply the DIACAP process to the NMCI/NGEN project.
